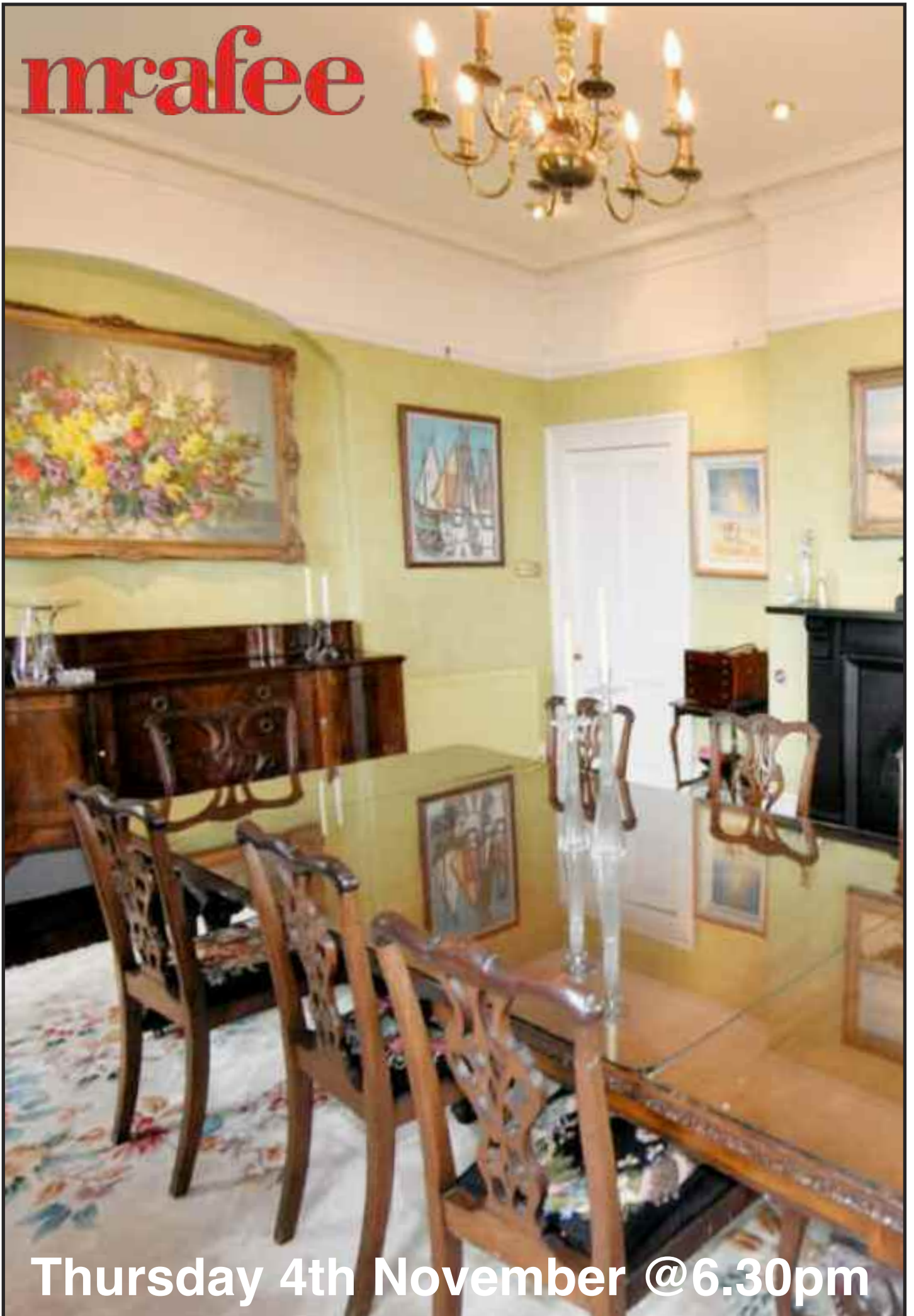

Conditions
